

Pool Rules

NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY - SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.

NO GLASS CONTAINERS PERMITTED IN POOL AREA.

NO PETS ALLOWED IN POOL AREA.

NO SMOKING/VAPING IN POOL AREA.

NO DIVING PERMITTED.

OCCUPANCY LIMIT 49 IN POOL AREA.

1. Children are the SOLE responsibility of their parent or guardian who must be present with the children at all times in the pool area.
2. A parent or guardian must accompany resident children under the age of 14.
A guardian must be at least 18 years of age.
3. Running and/or disorderly conduct is not permitted and may result in loss of pool privileges.
4. There may be random pool pass checks throughout the pool season.
5. The pool is for the exclusive use of the HOA homeowners and Estates recreational members to whom a key has been assigned and who have paid their current annual dues.
6. Do not loan out your pool key – if you do, you jeopardize your own pool privileges.
7. Proper swim attire must be worn at all times.
8. Balls, plastic toys, air mattresses, etc. will be permitted as long as they do not interfere with other members.
9. Bicycles, skateboards, scooters, etc...are not permitted within the pool area.
- 10.. Radios are permitted, as long as they do not interfere with other members.
11. Lockers are not provided – it is strongly recommended that members do not bring valuables to the pool area. The HOA assumes no responsibility for theft or damage to personal property.
13. Toddlers who are not potty trained must wear a swim diaper..
14. No person with digestive/intestinal tract problems or Covid Symptoms should be in the pool.
15. Pool furniture must not be removed from the pool area.
16. Appropriate behavior and language are required at all times.
17. If you lose your key, a replacement key can be purchased for \$25.00.
18. No private parties are allowed at the pool.
- 19. The pool is open from 9 am to 9 pm every day.**
- You must leave at 9pm and no one may enter after 9pm or before 9am!**
20. Please pick up your belongings. Any items left at the pool will be thrown away.
21. Please throw away all trash.
- 22.. Do not open the gate for someone who does not have pool privileges or a pool key.
23. Failure to abide by these rules may result in the loss of pool privileges.
